# CHIP FORM C

**CHIP:** K'ómoks First Nation Cultural Heritage Investigation Permit

**FORM C:** Site Alteration Permit (SAP) Application

K'ómoks First Nation's (KFN) Cultural Heritage Policy (CHP) is a fundamental part of the consultation process and allows KFN to make informed decisions about irreversible impacts to our cultural heritage.

K'ómoks First Nation's Cultural Heritage Investigation Permits (CHIPs) are required for all projects taking place within **registered archaeological sites** and in KFN's designated **areas of high archaeological potential (AOP)** within KFN's **core territory**. All ground disturbance including digging, filling, staking, ground leveling, excavation, trenching, and land clearing or grubbing in a registered archaeological site in KFN's core territory requires **both** a provincial Heritage Conservation Act (HCA) permit **and** a KFN CHIP.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

You will need to submit:

- 1 The attached form, completed
- 2 Site map
- 3 Development plans
- 4 Study Area Shapefiles
- 5 All previous archaeological reports
- 6 Copy of Provincial HCA (SAP)
  Permit application
- 7 Copy of Provincial HCA (SAP) Permit issuance (if available)

#### WHEN YOU NEED AN SAP CHIP FORM C

Once the KFN CHIP Form B Archaeological Impact Assessment (AIA) report is complete, it gets reviewed separately by both the KFN Archaeology Department the BC Archaeology Branch.

If the proponent chooses to move forward with the construction work and related archaeological mitigations as outlined in the report, and KFN agrees, an archaeologist must submit this SAP application, which will describe in detail the archaeological methodology that must be used to mitigate impacts to KFN Cultural Heritage during the ground disturbance phase of land development (i.e. excavation for a house foundation).

On occasion, an archaeologist may be able to apply for a Form B AIA and Form C SAP concurrently, when the project is very limited in scope, and the ground disturbance caused by the AIA investigation is almost equivalent to the final ground disturbance footprint of the project (i.e. installing a gas line or a hydro pole). Both K'ómoks First Nation and the BC Archaeology Branch would need to make the determination if the permits can be held concurrently.

KFN MUST APPROVE YOUR SAP PERMIT BEFORE ANY PROJECT GROUND DISTURBANCE BEGINS.



	I acknowledge that in order to be compliant with the KFN Cultural Heritage Policy, this project must include:
	Systematic data recovery (SDR) (via hand excavation units) of up to 50% of intact cultural sediments, with the remaining intact deposits excavated using a flat-bucket excavator in 10cm lifts. All intact deposits must be 100% screened by a qualified archaeologist and KFN representative. KFN may consider a decrease in SDR (minimum of 25%) on a case-by-case basis.
	100% raking and/or screening of disturbed deposits. This amount can be reduced (minimum of 25%) at the discretion of the field director, with written consent from the KFN Archaeology Department.
	Appropriate collection and analysis of <b>faunal and botanical remains</b> from every site where they are present, including column sampling from all stratified intact deposits.
	Appropriate collection and analysis of all <b>artifacts</b> (lithic, bone, antler, shell) from every site where they are present, including geochemical characterization (sourcing) of obsidian where present.
	Minimum of 1 radiocarbon date for every intact cultural layer where samples are available.
	Reasonable efforts to maintain the physical appearance of the site throughout the project.
	The archaeological materials will be properly reported with shapefiles by a qualified archaeologist to KFN and the BC Archaeology Branch within six weeks of identification.

	I acknowledge that the following actions are required if Ancestral Remains are encountered:
	Stop all work within 50m and notify KFN immediately.
	No further work within 50m of the Ancestor(s) until KFN has provided written instructions on how to proceed.
	Arrange for remuneration to KFN for costs associated with KFN site visits, meetings,monitoring, and repatriation (see Rate Sheet).
	I have read the KFN CHIP Information Guide.
	I acknowledge that all archaeological work requires a KFN Guardian or Monitor to be present, and that compensation for Guardians/Monitors will be arranged by the archaeologist.
	I acknowledge that all archaeological investigation and services will be performed by a qualified archaeologist, at the cost of the proponent.
	I acknowledge that hydro-vac and toothed bucket excavation are prohibited.
	I understand this CHIP is valid only for the activities specified above. If further archaeological work is required (e.g., SAP), a new CHIP will be required.
	I acknowledge that a CHIP is valid for two years. If the project extends beyond two years, a new CHIP will be required.
	I acknowledge that KFN has the right to terminate this permit at any time if I, the permit holder, do not adhere to the permit conditions as described in the KFN Cultural Heritage Policy.
