Voting Information Packages

Voting Packages will look a little different depending on when you enrolled under the treaty.

If you were enrolled before February 21

Eligible voters who enrolled before February 21 should have already received voting packages, including mail-in ballots, through Canada Post.

If you received a mail-in ballot and wish to by mail, please follow the instructions in your package and drop your completed mail-in ballot in any Canada Post mailbox by March 3, 2025. You may also bring your completed ballot to the in-person poll on March 8.

If you were enrolled after February 21

Eligible voters enrolled after February 21 and before March 4 will receive a voting package via Canada Post with instructions on how to vote online or by telephone. These packages do not include mail-in ballots. This was done because such ballots may not be received in time to be counted, and we want your vote to reach us in time for the deadline of March 8 at 8pm.

If you apply to enrol after March 4

Individuals who apply to enrol after March 4 and are eligible to vote may receive a voting information package by email or at the in-person poll on March 8.

When you receive your voting package

You can vote online or by telephone as soon as you receive your voting package in the mail.

Here's how:

- Open your Voter Information Package and find your unique Personal Identification Number (PIN)
- To vote online, go to komoks.isivote.com
- To vote by telephone, call 1-866-210-8530
